To protect against future flooding the US Army Corps of Engineers proposed a permanent, comprehensive flood protection system. This system includes the Greenway, a 2,200 acre recreational park system along the banks Red and Red Dark system along the banks Red and Red Lake Rivers.

The Greenway is the direct result of the devastating flood of 1997. After many months of brutally cold weather, twice the average snowfall, and a spring ice storm, the waters of the Red and Red Lake Rivers crested in a record-breaking flood. This historic event forever changed the landscape of Grand Forks and East Grand Forks.
