Bird Watching Journal

When you are watching and trying to identify birds look for:

- 1. Color: What color differences are there between the head and body? Similar birds have different colors. Male birds are usually more colorful.
- 2. Special Markings: Marks on wings or around eyes? Special stripes?
- 3. Size and Shape: Many birds look very similar and can be distinguished by size and shape.
- 4. Wings: Pointed, longer or shorter than the body?
- 5. Flight: Zigzag, straight flight?
- 6. Feeding Habits: Do the birds come to your feeder? Do you see the bird most often on the ground feeding?
- 7. Reference: Keep a reference book handy so you can look up the birds you see. This will help you identify them correctly.
