I. Old Business

- a. Special project request updates
 - i. Disc golf course at Riverside Park: The disc golf association has not submitted a redesigned course yet. The association is concerned that the approved course area can only accommodate six holes.

The Greenway Technical Committee advised the disc golf association that any changes to the original plan must go through the same informational and approval process. The second option is to redesign the course within the approved area.

- ii. Request for change to course in lower Lincoln Drive Park: The disc golf association has not submitted a realignment of the course.
- iii. Request for bocce ball & horseshoe pits: The committee would like to pursue this idea. There are several other ideas for amenities in this area. The City of Grand Forks will contact Maegin Rude about drawing a concept map for the area. This drawing would show all the suggested development for this area, including the bocce ball courts, horseshoe pits, and natural playground area. Kim will collect information on maintenance costs and issues.
- i. Boat house proposal: The GTC has some questions about the new proposed location of the boat house. They will be inviting Andy Magness from Ground Up Adventures to the December GTC staff meeting to discuss the progress of the proposal.
- b. **Share the Road:** Kim will draft a letter for the group to send to the mayor. This letter will request consideration to:
 - Provide a consistent visual identity for bike lanes and routes. This would be accomplished by painting all lanes stripes in green to differentiate from regular white street lines. All route signs should match these lines.
 - ii. Implement the recommended changes and additions by the group for better connections, especially making use of controlled crossings on busy streets.
 - iii. Submit an application for status as a Bicycle Friendly Community through the League of American Bicyclists.
