DISCUSSION ITEMS

- I. **2008 Brochure:** Copies of the latest brochure design were distributed. Please have any edits to Kim by Friday, February 15.
- II. **Greenway survey:** The results of the survey will be released to the public on Thursday, February 14 and will be available on the Greenway website. The survey showed that overall the respondents were pleased with how the Greenway was developed and is being maintained, but there is some misconception about how the operations and maintenance are funded. These issues will be addressed through a printed insert in the GF Herald promoting the project and answering the most frequently asked questions.
- III. **Dedication celebration:** Tentative plans are to host an event in early May in conjunction with National Bike Month. Kim is waiting for cost estimates for an eight page promotional piece to be inserted in the Grand Forks Herald at that same time.
- IV. **Service animal request:** Corey from Options made a request to consider changes to the Greenway Rules and Regulations (City ordinance for Grand Forks) regarding animals in the Greenway. The request is to add "Service animals shall be allowed in the Greenway when used by a person with a disability or for an animal undergoing training for sue as a service animal. The committee was unsure of the intent of the request. Kim will invite Corey to the April Greenway Technical Committee Staff meeting to discuss further.
- V. **Motorized vehicle definition update:** The sub committee met and formulated a draft definition for consideration. Kim has forwarded that draft to City Attorney Howard Swanson for review. The draft was also given to the East Grand Forks delegates for consideration by their City Attorney.
- VI. **Other**
 - **Disc Golf:** East Grand Forks plans to install their course this spring. The GF Park District is trying to work with the local disc golf group about the Lincoln Drive Park course but have had difficulty connecting with them.
