#### II. Old Business

#### A. River Access Master Plan - Update:

- Kim is compiling the comments from the public meetings into one document. Some of the ideas given were:
  - Wash points at each access point
  - Wayside parks along the river
  - More access points for canoes, etc.
  - Grated Slopes along the riverbank
  - Wood platforms
  - ♦ New location drop-off sites
  - More bike trails and nature areas
- The final plan will go before both City Councils for adoption later this year. This will give staff the authority to implement the plan.
- Tim stated that everyone on this committee should think about what they want to contribute to the plan. A plan is only a plan until put into action.
- Once this plan is completed, doors can open to many more things. (State funding)
- This plan is for recreation **on** the river not the trails or park system.
- The Park Districts (GF and EGF) should bring their plans to comment/contribute to the plan.

#### B. Downtown Trail and Dock Project - Update:

- The new trail and dock project has not been completed. The wet weather has held back the progress.
- Tony Anderson (managed by KLJ) is working on site today with plans to pour cement tomorrow.
- The specialized dock is still in route to Grand Forks.

• Weather permitting, the trail and dock should be completed by the end of July.

# C. Kennedy Bridge - Update:

- This project appears to be on hold for now.
- There is an issue with meeting ADA compliance to get from the pedestrian walkway to the trail in EGF. There is a steep slope at this connection point.

## **D. Special Project Requests:**

- Skunk Trapping Project:
  - A couple of committee members have seen the UND students working on the project.
  - ◆ This is a three year project.
  - A couple of skunks were trapped that Wes had spotted. These skunks were too young for the study. Only adult skunks are permitted for this study.

## VI. Agency Updates

#### A. City of EGF:

- The Parks and Rec Department has an agreement with Altru Health System.
  - Altru will give the Parks and Rec Department \$450,000 over a period of 10 years.
  - Some of the money will support health and wellness events in EGF.
  - Altru will have advertising at the arenas.
  - Altru will sponsor turf in the civic center for when not in use for hockey.
  - This is not an exclusive agreement. Other health agencies (Sanford, etc.) will also be able to advertise.
- The pool is doing well.
- Interviews are being held for the Parks and Rec. Supervisor.

## **B. GF** Fire Department:

There was an emergency call from the site of the new trail and dock this morning.
 An intoxicated man on a bicycle crossed onto the blocked trail. He then crashed where the additional trail is being constructed. The man was taken to Altru by ambulance.

- Wes inquired about controlled burns on the Greenway. This is not something that the Fire Department does at this time.
- The biggest threat for the Fire Department regarding the Greenway is access to the site.

## C. City of GF:

- Stephanie reported that Simonson's Lumber has a permit for demolition of their building on 3<sup>rd</sup> Street N. The new trail will go around the front and come up on 3<sup>rd</sup> Street N. The path will be 8ft wide.
- Jairo reported that the MPO is continuing to work on the Bicycle and Pedestrian Survey and Plan.

#### D. GF Park District:

- Bill reported that the pools are down an estimated 6,000 swimmers due to the recent weather.
- There is a big wedding in Riverside Park August 4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup>, and 6<sup>th</sup>. Preparations will begin on the 4<sup>th</sup>. A tent has been rented from Minneapolis.
- The Greater Grand Forks Soccer Tournament is coming up this weekend.

## E. Greenway:

- Kim attended the Environmental Systems Research Institute (ESRI Conference).
  - ◆ 5 day conference 16,000 people in attendance.
  - There were demonstrations on how to use data to create better work flow, tell a story and draw people into the area.
  - Attended presentations on sidewalk inventory and ADA compliance by a speaker from Clearwater, Florida. Clearwater was involved in a lawsuit because of an injury related to a sidewalk and trail. The session empathized that having a written maintenance plan is important, especially in a lawsuit.
  - The Greenway could use the ESRI software and data to develop a program for pavement management. Kim is working with the city IT department to develop a beta test phone app for this project.

#### F. Minnesota DNR:

- Campsite was full last week and has already filled up for this weekend.
- Turned away 20 campers last week.
